NOTICE OF MUNICIPAL OFFICES To be voted on in the Huntington City General Election November 7, 2023

THERE WILL BE ELECTIONS THIS YEAR FOR THE FOLLOWING:

Three – 4-year City Council positions

Candidate filing period begins June 1, 2023 and ends at 5:00 p.m. on June 7, 2023 (excluding weekend). Declaration of Candidacy must be filed in person at the Huntington City Recorder's Office located at 20 south Main Street, Huntington.

MUNICIPAL CANDIDATE QUALIFICATIONS

- Registered voter in the municipality in which the individual is elected;
- Must have resided within the municipality for which the candidate is seeking office for the 12 consecutive months immediately before the date of the election;
- Maintain a principal place of residence within the municipality, and within the district that the elected officer represents, during the officer's term of office;
- If the individual resides in a territory which was annexed into the municipality; must have resided within the annexed territory of the municipality the 12 consecutive months immediately before the date of election;
- Not convicted of a felony.
