## Healthcare Provider CPR Course

The Healthcare Provider (HCP) course is a 3-hour classroom lecture and manipulative skills course that meets the OSHA / WISHA regulations as listed in the Washington Administrative Code (WAC).

This course is intended for participants who provide health care to patients in a wide variety of settings including in-hospital and out-of-hospital. Healthcare Provider CPR is for certified or non-certified, licensed or non-licensed, healthcare professionals. The intended audience includes, but is not limited to physicians, nurses, paramedics, EMT's, respiratory therapists, physical and occupational therapists, physician's assistants, medical or nursing assistants, or other allied health personnel.

Topics and skills covered:

- Bloodborne / Airborne pathogens
  - HIV / HBV / TB
- Exposure protection / Personal Protective Equipment
  - Managing an exposure / Documentation
- Foreign body airway obstruction
  - Adult, child, and infant
- CPR (HCP protocols)
  - Adult, child, and infant
- Rescue breathing
  - Adult, child, and infant
- Oxygen delivery using Bag Valve Mask (BVM) device
- Automatic External Defibrillation (AED)
  - Adult and child 1 year and older

The focus for the HCP course is on significant manipulative skills training with an emphasis on the team approach. 3 Sixty Training classes exceed the widely recognized national standards for Healthcare provider CPR.
