

Thoughts on sound and silence:

Have you ever tried opening a cough drop in a quiet room or while someone everyone else is listening to a speaker? Or have you sat in the early morning by a lake and heard a loon's call echo over the entire lake? The silence around us amplifies the sound, regardless of whether they sound is annoying or beautiful. What "sounds" do I make? What words to I speak that are amplified by my life? St. Paul reminds us in that familiar piece to the Corinthians "If I speak with the tongues of angels, but have no love, I am a clashing cymbal, a noisy gong."

Have you ever stood out in the snow as it was falling and notice how quiet the world seemed? Or have you ever had the power go out for a while and realized how quiet your house/apartment was without the low hums of the refrigerator, furnace, dishwasher, computer, TV, etc.? There is almost a felt freedom when the sounds that constantly assail are no longer there - the sounds that are so much a part of our experience that we don't even hear them anymore. What sounds do I no longer hear as a go about my day? Do I really listen to those who are speaking to me? Do I pay attention to the voice of God constantly around me? Psalm 46 reminds us, *Be still, and know that I am God.*"

May you be still enough to listen, so that when you speak, you speak out of love.


