United States Post Office - 65 Franklin Street





Across the street from the once RR station, now stands Franklin's only post office. Where once there were post offices both in Franklin Falls (now simply Franklin) and West Franklin (originally just called Franklin), there was to be one main office. The Post Offices were constantly moved from one place to another for many years. The land was owned by JH Davis and construction began in 1921 and the building opened for business in 1922. In one construction photo (courtesy of the Franklin Post Office) the breezeway and part of the driveway of the railroad station can be seen. Did you know the first free street mail delivery was not until December 1903? Each carrier had a route of 12 miles or more.
