

Horse Trailer Comes Unhitched In I-70 Mishap

An accident involving a tractor and an empty horse trailer Thursday at the New Paris overpass on I-70 east of Richmond demolished the trailer and badly damaged the tractor.

According to the Wayne County Sheriff's Department, a vehicle driven by James Bartlett, 30, of 133 Brad Road, Tipp City, Ohio, was pulling an empty horse trailer on the interstate when it came unhitched.

The loose trailer then slid into a tractor driven by James Meehan, 42, of 8778 Donna St., Westland, Mich.

The trailer was demolished in the accident, while \$65 damage was reported to the tire and fender of the tractor.

Neither driver was injured in the accident.
