1912 - 1996

Earle E. Robinson, 84 of Bradenton, FL., and formerly of Pigeon, passed away in Bradenton on June 26, following a lengthy illness.

He was born May 16, 1912 in Marquette and graduated from Northern State Teachers College in 1936 with a Bachelor's Degree. He started his career in education as a coach and vocational shop teacher. He taught schools in Stephenson, MI and in Pigeon in the 1940s. He served in the Air Force during World War II. He retired as Director of Vocational Education from Saginaw Public Schools

In 1946 he married Helen Appel who was also on the faculty of Pigeon High School as a home economics teacher. They had no children. Mr. Robinson was a life member of the MEA and the AEA and received many honors throughout his 36-year career in vocational education.
