All students in the 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th grades who attend public, private or parochial schools are eligible to enter.

Annual Themes:

2016 – 2017 Why is it important to vote?

Contest Rules:

- ☑ All students must address the theme.
- All essays may be written in ink, typed or produced on a computer.
- 6th Grade students should submit essays of 200 words or less.
- **▼** 7th and 8th Grade students should submit essays of 300 words or less.
- 9th and 10th Grade students should submit essays of 400 words or less.
- 11th and 12th Grade students should submit essays of 500 words or less.
- All national entries must be postmarked by July 1. Local and state deadlines may vary.
