PHOTOGRAPHERS TAKE PICTURES."***

Deal Toney will make a presentation on how we see and interpret images, including how our culture influences our perceptions. He says "Pictures are all around you, you just have to see them."

He started as a sculptor, evolving over time into photography and continues both genres.

Mr. Toney was a combat photo-journalist for the Air Force for 23 years and has taken photos on every continent. He photographed the release of POWs from Vietnam and China, the Jonestown recovery, the Canary Island 747 disaster, the earthquakes in the Azores Islands and the release of the Iranian embassy hostages. Mr.

Toney has had two Pulitzer Prize nominations for his outstanding photography. Outside of the military, he has had many assignments including photographing the King and Queen of Thailand and the Dutch Royal Family. His articles and photographs have been published throughout the U.S., as well as internationally.

Mr. Toney has taught classes on 'Photography For Publication' at Missouri State University and Computer Science at Ozarks Technical College.
