

ERNEST TSCHUMI, Elkton—

Ernest Tschumi, 68, died Thursday at his farm home near Elkton after suffering a heart attack. Born Nov. 16, 1890, in Switzerland, he came when 12 years of age to the Elkton vicinity. He was an accomplished artist and painted as a hobby. He and the former Miss Anna Jahr, of Sebewaing, were married in 1918. She died in 1951. He and Hertha Herford were married in 1952. Surviving are his widow; a daughter, Mrs. Virginia Ackerman, of Elkton, two step-daughters; four grandchildren; one great grandchild; six step-grandchildren; and a sister, Mrs. Fred Niebel, of Pigeon. Funeral services will be held Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock at St. Paul's Evangelical UB church. The Rev. Morris Bauman will officiate and burial will be in the Pigeon cemetery. The body is at the Colgan Funeral chapel here.
