Vineyard and Terroir

- **Location:** The vineyards are situated on alluvial soils along the Ebro River, within the Haro region of Rioja.
- **Soil Type:** Deep alluvial soils with a loamy-sandy texture and abundant pebbles, enhancing ripening.
- Viticulture Practices: Grapes are sourced from estate-owned vineyards in the Haro region, where careful vineyard management ensures optimal ripening and quality. The vineyards benefit from deep alluvial soils and a continental climate that contributes to the freshness and balance characteristic of Viña Pomal wines.

Winemaking

- Harvest: Grapes are destemmed, lightly macerated (6 hours), and then pressed.
- Aging: The wine is aged for 4 months in a blend of American and French oak barrels. Lees stirring is performed periodically to enhance complexity, body, and structure, contributing subtle toasty notes to the wine.

Tasting Notes

- Appearance: Pale yellow with greyish steel hues.
- **Aroma:** White fruit, citrus, and fennel, with light toastiness from oak aging.
- Palate: Fresh and balanced, with fruit notes, salinity, and good
- Finish: The wine has a fresh and balanced finish, with lingering notes of citrus, salinity, and subtle oak, providing a clean and refined aftertaste.
