TO Suffragan Bishops and District Elders of the Northern District Council:

The following process will be utilized for establishing the Northern District Council's compliance with the initiatives found in the Pentecostal Assemblies of the World, Inc. (P.A.W. Inc.) Manifesto of the Minute book.

All Suffragan Bishops and District Elders will be required to go through the Compliance Review Committee which will include the following steps:

1. Screening and background for all of us, including the Diocesan Bishop. This would include proof that we have all the necessary qualifications and identify areas in which continuing education through Aenon Bible College/Transformational Leadership training will be beneficial.
2. Ethics orientation on the laws of ethics found in the PAW Minute Book as well as well as the Council Ethics Policies forthcoming.
3. ***Credentialing of all Northern District Council leadership to include resumes, copies of degrees, certifications, credentials, and accreditations in all areas of academia which may be beneficial to service in the body of Christ/NDC.***
4. Review and Reform to include review of all officers (who are Pastors) compliance with P.A.W., Inc. law in following areas:
 - a. Church Bylaws/constitution
 - b. Church property held in trust by a legitimate board of trustees
 - c. Church Insurance/Key Person Insurance
 - d. Church succession plans in place which clearly state a process for perpetuity of the church and that follows the example of Jesus Christ who prepared the Apostles to succeed him. (2Timothy 2:1-3)
