

# MARGARET BURSICK

1900 - 1992

Former San Francisco resident Margaret A. Bursick, 92 of Bad Axe, passed away Tuesday, Dec. 1 at Huron Memorial Hospital, Bad Axe after a long illness.

She was born Aug. 12, 1900 in Oliver Township, daughter of the late Frank and Elenora (Lameski) Bursick. She was a graduate of Elkton High School and the Detroit Institute of Business, employed for nine years at Burroughs Corp., Detroit. She moved to San Francisco and was employed as a legal secretary from 1947 to 1984. A proficient musician in piano and organ selections, Ms. Bursick enjoyed concerts, the opera and travel. She has lived in the Bad Axe area since 1984, where she was a parishioner of Sacred Heart Catholic Church.
