Gaming News

Circus Circus sale

In an interview on Forbes.com, Phil Ruffin said he wants to sell Circus Circus and its 102 acres and 2,000 feet of north Strip Las Vegas frontage. Ruffin picked up Circus only six years ago for \$825 million, claims its worth \$5 billion today, and told Forbes that there's plenty of interest from buyers. Ruffin cited his purchase of the Frontier in 1998, ending the long bitter strike there. He paid \$167 million, then sold it in 2007 for \$1.2 billion. "Why do you think I bought Circus Circus? For the 102 acres," he told the magazine. "That's the land play. Remember what I did at the Frontier, how the value of the land went crazy? [With Circus], it's going crazier." Ruffin bought Treasure Island for \$775 million and told Forbes he's looking to acquire another Strip property after unloading the Clown show; he's also looking at properties outside of Nevada.

Big name boycott

For the first time in 37 years, Phil Hellmuth, the Poker Hall of Famer, 1989 World Series of Poker Main Event champion, and number-one WSOP bracelet holder (17), will not participate in this year's Main Event. Hellmuth told Poker.org, "If the WSOP Main Event does not give us a day off after Day 3 or Day 4, I will not play in it. I told the WSOP as much a few months ago. Thus, this will end my run; I've played the Main Event every year since 1988." Hellmuth, who'll turn 61 during this year's WSOP, has complained for years that the tournament's length and format have turned the event into "a marathon and more of a test of endurance than an overall skill set. This proportionally negatively affects those who are older. I know of three of the biggest names in poker who bonked out. They got way too tired and blew it due to fatigue." Hellmuth will, however, play in other WSOP events.

Second Navajo casino

A second Navajo casino is coming to the Flagstaff, Arizona area after the tribe secured legal authority to build a gaming hall on a 13.79-acre site northeast of the city. The casino is planned on property that was home to Horsemen Lodge steakhouse since 1975 and the adjacent Flying Heart Stables. The site is outside the city limits on U.S 89, about four miles north of Flagstaff Mall. The new casino, referred to as the Lower 89 Project, will be permitted to have up to 300 gaming devices, according to the Tribal-State Gaming Pact of 2021. Nygren said the Gaming Enterprise plans to reopen Horsemen Lodge steakhouse. "Despite concerns some have expressed, I fully expect the reopening of the restaurant will be welcomed by the local community and Highway 89 travelers. Horseman's Lodge was an iconic establishment, and it's been greatly missed since it closed its doors in June 2020 because of Covid."

New VA Secretary Doug Collins

Changes are coming fast and furious at the Department of Veterans Affairs. Since these impact many of us, we need to pay attention to what's going on — and who's now in charge.

The VA has a new secretary, Douglas A. Collins, the 12th in the position since the VA was started in 1988. Collins is an Air Force veteran, served as chaplain, has been a Reserve colonel for 23 years and additionally served for two years in the Navy. He served in Iraq and at his confirmation hearing said that he slept next to burn pits for many months. He's an attorney and was a U.S. representative for a Georgia district from 2013 to 2021.

Quite the resume, and the Senate vote to confirm him was fairly strong: 77 to 23.

He's jumped right in, saying he wants to expand the VA's private sector care and figure out how to get rid of employees who aren't doing their job. He stopped the employee teleworking right away, insisting people come back to work, and put a hiring freeze in place until things shake out and they see if there are any vacancies once people decide if they're staying or going. Further, he vowed to fix the \$16 billion computer system that's been sitting unfinished for two years.

Sometimes you just want to see a man and hear his voice before you make up your mind about him. Go online to YouTube and look for "Doug Collins opening remarks in Veterans Affairs secretary confirmation hearing."

Watching that video, I liked things about him that have nothing directly to do with the VA and the position he's been given, but instead tell what kind of a man he is. He's been married 36 years, he still has a bracelet a female Airman made for him when he was a flightline chaplain 15 years ago and he thanked his 88-year-old father. In the end, those things matter.

I wish him well.

Buzzing at Bingo

Hi Guy,

We are having a problem with cell-phone users at Bingo. People are lowering the volume somewhat but are not turning their cell phones off, so all night you hear little chirps and beeps and songs. Others turn their phones to "vibrate" so that you do not hear them ring, but they rattle on the table—which is equally noisy and distracting.

Don't you think there should be a rule for Bingo halls that is the same for movie theaters—where people are required to shut off their cell phones during the movie so as not to disturb the other patrons? — **Stephen, Massachusetts, via email**

Hi Stephen,

Shutting off cell phones in movie theaters is not so much a rule as it is a courtesy—the theater operators ask that people turn them off, but patrons who choose not to do so are not breaking any laws; they're just being jerks.

Lots of Bingo halls require that people shut off their cell phones before Bingo begins. Often, they will make an announcement before the start of Bingo, much like movie theaters do.

Because Bingo halls are licensed entities, they are allowed to make and enforce hall rules—for example: no players under age 16, no bringing in food or drinks from home, no sharing of Bingo packs, etc.

If halls choose to make a no-cell-phone rule, it can be enforced as well. And I think they should. For emergency reasons, however, I think the vibrate function should be permitted—for text only. People just need to have the common sense/courtesy to keep their phones in their pockets and not leave them on the gaming tables to buzz and rattle and disturb other players. —**Guy**

Ask Annie

Winging it

Dear Annie,

We are having a big party and I want to serve chicken wings. Can you make some suggestions for recipes? Thank you. — **Marilyn D from The Villages, Florida**

Dear Marilyn,

I love chicken wings. Here are three of my favorite recipes. If you are serving a big crowd, prepare all three recipes. —**Annie**

SWEET AS CAN BE WINGS

3 lbs. chicken wings
½ c. honey
¼ c. soy sauce
4 T. brown sugar
1 clove garlic, crushed
¼ cup catsup
Salt, to taste
Pepper, to taste
Paprika

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees. Line a shallow baking pan with aluminum foil. Place the chicken in the pan. Sprinkle with salt, pepper and paprika. In a medium mixing bowl, combine the honey, soy sauce, brown sugar and catsup. Pour over the chicken wings. Bake for 35 to 45 minutes. Test for doneness. Makes 18 servings.

BUFFALO CHICKEN

3 T. fat-free margarine
2 T. hot pepper sauce, or more to taste
1 tsp. canola oil
3 lbs. chicken wings
¼ tsp. salt

1/8 tsp. freshly ground black pepper
3 celery stalks, cut into 1-inch pieces
Blue Cheese dressing

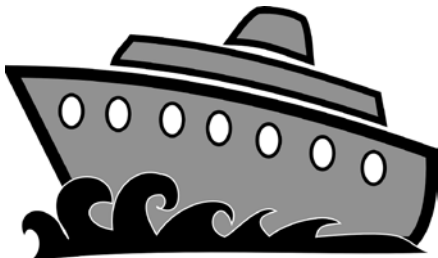
Melt margarine in a medium non-stick saucepan. Whisk in pepper sauce and cook for 1 to 2 minutes, or until slightly thickened; set aside. Heat oil in a large nonstick skillet over medium-high heat. Season chicken with salt and pepper, add to pan, and cook, turning occasionally, until browned on all sides, about 6 minutes. Add margarine mixture to pan and gently toss chicken until well coated, 1 to 2 minutes. Serve with celery pieces and blue cheese dressing. Serves 18.

FIVE SPICE CHICKEN WINGS

2 scallions, chopped
½ cup soy sauce
½ cup dry sherry
¼ cup brown sugar
2 tsp. Chinese 5-spice seasoning
1 tsp. sesame oil
4 lbs. chicken wings

Using a large heavy saucepan, combine all of the above ingredients except the chicken. Bring to a boil for a medium heat. Add the chicken and simmer. Stir constantly. Cook for 30 minutes with a lid on the saucepan. You can find the seasoning in an Oriental grocery, if not available in your regular grocery store. Serves 12.

Ask Dr. Roach

Chest pains

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am an 84-year-old male in amazingly good health and have great physical abilities, but after running about 3 miles, I noticed some minor chest discomfort. After a calcium score test and stress test, my doctor wanted to place stents in my coronary arteries.

I read a National Institute of Health study from 2020 regarding stent outcomes versus medication and lifestyle changes, and it showed no difference in the outcomes. So, I decided not to do the stents.

I no longer do any distance running, but I do weight training and a stationary bike exercise for 10 minutes without any chest issues. I now take statin drugs, blood pressure medicines, and baby aspirin.

Are you familiar with this study, and am I doing a reasonable thing by not having the stents inserted? — T.E.



Paw’s Corner

DEAR PAWS: I took over the care of a rabbit named “Chucky” a few weeks ago, after the previous owner, my aunt, passed away. Since he got here, Chucky has spent most of his days inside his hutch. When I try to take him out, he huddles tightly against the far wall. I don’t see him eat or drink during the day, but he does come out at night after I go to bed. Is he depressed, or is it something else? — Jim F., Chula Vista, California

DEAR JIM: Chucky does sound pretty stressed out, and depression is definitely on the table here. He also may be having trouble adjusting to his new environment. A stressed and unhappy rabbit is tense, staying in a down position with their ears flattened. Their nose doesn’t twitch. They don’t hop around the cage freely, and they’ll hide away if you reach for them.

The first thing to do is establish care, if you haven’t done so already. Take Chucky to a veterinarian specializing in small animals for a checkup, explain the circumstances, and detail his behaviors. The vet will rule out any underlying health conditions and can give you a wealth of advice on helping him be more comfortable and easing his transition to a new owner.

It’s important to be supportive and not force interaction at this time. Keep Chucky’s cage clean and fresh, change his water and food daily, and provide him with rabbit toys and chews strewn around the cage that he can explore. Talk to him in a soothing voice while you are near his cage. As he adjusts, he will gradually respond and feel comfortable with you.

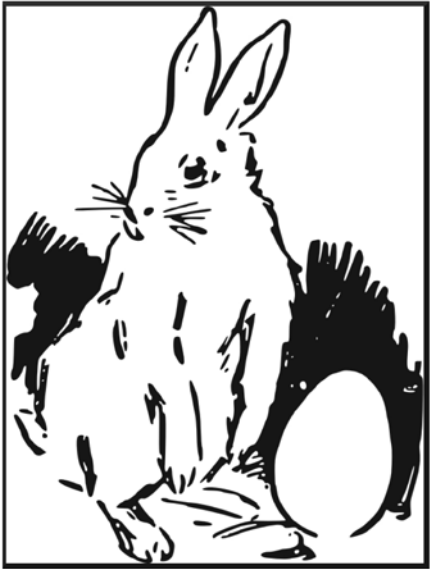
ANSWER: Whether stents are beneficial in people with stable coronary artery disease remains somewhat controversial. Although stents in combination with a healthy diet, exercise and medication may improve symptoms better than lifestyle changes and medication alone, there are no data to show an improvement in lifespan or in preventing heart attacks.

Your cardiologist wanted to reduce your symptoms, but if you aren’t having any now, then stenting isn’t indicated. If you had to reduce your running because of chest discomfort, then stenting might possibly allow you to do more exercise without having these symptoms.

Missing Bingo ball

My closest experience to this was a Bingo session at a local community center where a particular ball also did not come up. About three-quarters of the way through the session a sharp-eyed player saw that a ball was stuck in the corner of the blower. When it was jiggled loose it was revealed to be the "missing" ball.

After that, all hell broke loose. Losers were furious, winners were afraid they might lose their winnings—it was not a pretty scene. The hall manager finally announced that anyone was welcome to a refund due to the technical error. The majority of players took their money and walked...including two people who had won jackpots!

To me, a refund is the only fair way to deal with the situation. The mistake was not intentional, and the manager was right—there was no guarantee the number would have come up for the angry winner. But the number of balls was wrong, so the entire session is a forfeit. — *Aunt Bingo*

Savvy Senior

“You ask the senior question, we find the savvy answer!”

Do you need a digital will?

Dear Savvy Senior,

My wife and I had our estate plan—including a will, power of attorney and advance directive—drawn up about 20 years ago but have recently read that our plan should include a digital will too. What can you tell us about this? — **Almost 80**

Dear Almost,

If you or your wife spend much time online, adding a separate digital will document to your estate plan that provides a list of your digital assets would be extremely helpful to your loved ones when you die, not to mention it will help protect your privacy. Here’s what you should know.

DO YOU HAVE DIGITAL ASSETS?

The term “digital assets” refers to personal information that is stored electronically on either a computer or an online cloud server account that belongs to an individual. Anyone who uses email, has a PIN code protected cell phone, makes online purchases, or pays bills online has digital assets. Digital assets generally require a username, a password, or a PIN to access and can be difficult if not impossible to retrieve if someone is incapacitated or passes away. Creating a digital will (also known

as a digital estate plan) will help your loved ones access your electronic devices and online accounts more easily so they can manage your electronic affairs, according to your wishes, after you’re gone. This in turn will also protect your digital assets from hackers or fraud, which can happen to dormant accounts after you die.

HOW TO WRITE A DIGITAL WILL

Your first step in creating a digital will is to make an inventory list of your digital assets, which includes everything from hardware to email accounts. Here are a few categories to help kick-start your list:

- * Electronic devices (computer, smartphone, tablet, external hard drive).
- * Digital files (for photos, videos or documents)
- * Financial accounts (like bank and brokerage accounts, credit cards, cryptocurrency).
- * Bill paying accounts (utilities, mortgage accounts)
- * Social media accounts (like Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, LinkedIn).
- * Email accounts (Gmail, Yahoo, Outlook, etc.).
- * Cloud-storage accounts (like Google Cloud, iCloud, Dropbox, Microsoft OneDrive)
- * Movie or music streaming services (like Netflix, Hulu, Spotify, Apple Music)
- * Online purchasing accounts (like Venmo or PayPal)
- * Subscription services (magazines, newspapers, Amazon Prime, etc.).
- * Reward programs (travel, stores, etc.).

- * Membership organizations (AARP, AAA, etc.).
- When making your list, you’ll need to include usernames, passwords, PINS, account numbers or security questions for accessing each account. And provide instructions on how you want your assets managed after your death. For example: Do you want certain accounts closed, archived or transferred? Do you want specific files or photos to be deleted or shared with loved ones? Do you want your social media profiles memorialized or deleted? Be clear and specific about your wishes.
- You’ll also need to appoint a digital executor that you trust to execute your wishes after you die.
- Rutgers University offers a Digital Assets Inventory Worksheet that can help you get started.
- From a legal perspective, you should know that most states have enacted the Revised Uniform Fiduciary Access to Digital Assets Act (RUFADAA), which legally recognizes digital estates. This law gives your personal representative or executor legally protected access to your online accounts.
- Once your digital will is written, store it with your other estate plan documents either in a fireproof safe or file cabinet at home, on your computer hard drive, with your estate planning attorney or online at a reputable digital estate planning service like Everplans.com or Clocr.com. But make sure your executor knows where it is and has access to it.
- Also remember to keep your digital will updated regularly when you create any new digital accounts or change passwords.

Poker Talk

Know the implied odds

Whenever you face a bet at the poker table, it is important to consider your immediate risk, your future potential risk, and also the amount you can potentially profit. Sometimes you should play speculative hands — like small pairs and suited connectors — and other times they should be folded.

Suppose someone raises to two big blinds (bbs) and you have a solid speculative hand like the 8c6c on the button, which is likely the worst hand at the moment but can improve to a premium hand like a flush or a straight.

The amount you can potentially win from your opponent should be one of your main concerns. If you can only win a little bit from your opponent because they have a short stack of perhaps 26bbs or fewer, you should fold because the potential reward (26bbs) is not worth the risk (2bbs). This is expressed as 13:1 implied odds. You have to invest 1 unit to potentially win 13. If you are both deep stacked with 100bbs though, you should play because you will then be getting 50:1 implied odds.

As a generalization, in order to profitably play a suited connected hand like 7c7s or a marginal suited Ace like the Ah7h, you need to be getting 20:1 implied odds or more, assuming you do not expect to be able to win the pot by bluffing too often. With small pairs, you need about 10:1 implied odds. If you are not getting the

correct implied odds either because the stacks are shallow or the initial raise is too large, you either have to fold or use your hand as a reraise bluff.

While small pairs, suited Aces, and suited connectors have implied odds, some hands have reverse implied odds, meaning they will usually either win a small pot or lose a large pot. The hands that have the worst reverse implied odds are a big card with a small card that are not suited, such as Ks6c or Qd7d.

Imagine you see the flop and make top pair, which is normally a strong hand. If you bet and all your opponents fold, you can be confident you had the best hand, but you are rewarded with only a small pot. If instead you bet and someone calls or raises, they could have a better top pair than yours or a worse hand, but you have no way of knowing which.

If you bet the flop and they call, if you continue betting on the turn and river, you will find that when you get called, it will usually be by a better hand, resulting in you losing a large pot.

Because of this, hands with large reverse implied odds should not be played in most situations, especially in multi-way pots or when the stacks are deep.

As stacks get deeper and the pots are played multi-way, you are more incentivized to speculate with hands that will either lose a little or win a lot, which are primarily the small pairs, suited Aces, and suited connectors. Folding the non-premium offsuit hands will keep you out of trouble and save you a lot of money.

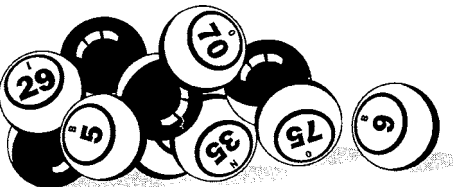
