Division Rules

1. Rabbits must be tattooed in the left ear corresponding to number listed on the entry form.
2. Rabbits will be examined at check-in for signs of external parasites, abscesses, snuffles, sore hocks, and diarrhea. Affected animals must be removed at once from the show area.
3. Rabbit Meat Pens, Pet Rabbits, and Doe and Litter are not eligible for Best of Show award.
