

SPOTLIGHT ON HEALTH

Hydration:

- Drink plenty of fluids: Water is the best choice, but unsweetened iced tea or sports drinks can also help replenish electrolytes.
- Eat hydrating foods: Fruits and vegetables like watermelon, cucumbers, and berries are good options.
- Be mindful of dehydrating drinks: Limit caffeine and sugary beverages.

Sun Protection:

- Seek shade: Especially between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. when the sun's rays are strongest.
- Wear protective clothing: Long sleeves, hats, and sunglasses can help.
- Apply sunscreen: Use a broad-spectrum sunscreen with SPF 30 or higher, and reapply every two hours, especially after swimming or sweating

Heat Safety:

- Know the signs of heat-related illnesses: Heat exhaustion and heatstroke can be serious.
- Stay cool: Spend time in air-conditioned places when possible, use fans, and take cool showers.
- Pace yourself: Reduce outdoor activity during peak heat hours and take breaks.

<u>Healthy Habits:</u>

- Eat light and healthy: Focus on fresh fruits, vegetables, and lean proteins.
- Exercise safely: Choose cooler times of the day for outdoor activities and be mindful of the heat.
- Practice food safety: Be careful when handling and storing food at outdoor gatherings.




