1. **Selectmen Meeting was called to order approximately at 6:32 PM by Jeffrey Sanborn.**

2. **Review/ Approve meeting minutes**

Jim Dolloff made a motion to accept and approve May 22nd, 2018 meeting minutes. Dwight Warren seconded the motion. Selectmen voted 3-0 to approve meeting minutes.

**Maietta Update**

Wes brought detailed pictures of Maietta pit. He reported 4 – 6 acres of phase 2 area had been reclaimed. Wes was on-site Wed/ Thurs and Friday observing and taking photos. On May 18<sup>th</sup>, Wes took photos of the phase 2 area before the reclaim work began. Wes reported it was a satisfactory job. He dug a few test holds and the loam was all 4" or deeper and had good soil content. They used chopped hay and no seed was used. Wes was concerned that he used the hay to seed the loam. Need to contact attorney David Lourie to discuss whether to get an engineer involved for further inspection

**Fema Meeting Update**

Representatives from Fema came to the office to review October 2017 damages with the staff on Thursday, May 31<sup>st</sup>. James Houle ran the meeting as the PDMG. Also in attendance was Margaret Cushing from Cumberland County, Brian Anderson, Jeff Sanborn, Danielle Taylor and Phyllis a site inspector from Fema. On the phone was Chris representing NHJFO and Bill Hasham representing historic preservation. Damages were reviewed. The Town has 60 days to get the requested information into Fema for expense reimbursement.
