This is an excellent opportunity to observe the printmaking process-learn how a plate is made, prepared for printing and how to properly set up the press.

Mina Tang Kan received her Master of Arts in Printmaking from California State University, Long Beach, California, served on the faculty of that college, and later at El Camino College, Golden West College and the Palos Verdes Art Center. She has instructed in painting, design, drawing, printmaking, photographic imagery, and art history.

Her prints include woodcuts, etchings, photo-etchings, and monoprints. Her work has been exhibited in Los Angeles, Paris, London, Hawaii, Korea and Arizona and is included in many fine private and corporate art collections.
