## **Levi H. Walter Scholarship Award**

The Levi H. Walter Scholarship is awarded in honor of Levi H. Walter by his son, Dr. Bruce Walter. Levi H. Walter taught school in Kimmel Township and later was Secretary for the Kimmel Township School Board.

Two scholarship awards will be given each year in the amount of \$1,000 for the first year renewable up to \$200 per year for three additional years upon proof of continued successful enrollment in a post-secondary program. The renewable award will fluctuate depending on the current interest rates.

Criteria:

-must be accepted at a post-secondary degree or certificate granting institution and continue toward the degree or certification in order to be eligible for renewal.

-applicants **must complete the attached application**

-applicants are considered on the basis of their qualifications in the following areas: scholarship, character traits, school activity involvement, leadership qualities, school attendance, and community and home involvement.

Scholarship funds shall be administered through the Claysburg Education Foundation and provided to the recipient upon proof of being a student as outlined in above.

The scholarship applications must be received by the Claysburg Education Foundation by end of day on April 30 of each year from the graduating senior.
