**GENERAL FUNCTION:** The duties of the Distribution Technician consist of those jobs necessary, but not limited to, the operation, maintenance, repair and construction of water distribution facilities. These duties include all work, in compliance with Company and regulatory requirements, associated with service of distribution system piping, hydrants, valves, customer services, booster stations, and all other components related to a distribution system.

**RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES:**

- Operates and maintains water distribution system facilities, such as water mains, valves, hydrants, service lines, etc. Utilizes company technology to ensure assigned work is captured within work order management applications.
- Ensures daily work complies with OEPA and PUCO regulatory requirements for operations. Ensures that daily work complies with established company safety policies.
- Operates and performs maintenance on all equipment and vehicles used in the maintenance of the water system.
- Reads and interprets maps, drawings and schematics to include GIS data.
- Performs field service representative and meter reading work as assigned.
- Satisfactorily meets internal and external customer requirements through effective communication and initiative. Proficient in communicating via email and text.
- Responds to after hour calls to for emergency and non emergency situations as required. Available for scheduled overtime.
- All other duties assigned by management.



**SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL OR REGISTRATION QUALIFICATIONS:**

Must have a high school diploma or the GED equivalent. Must be available for emergency work after regular working hours, weekends and for scheduled overtime. Must be capable of lifting 100 lbs.
