REGISTRATION

This tournament is for girls who play in the recreational leagues in their hometown. Select and travel teams are not allowed to participate. Many girls play on both types of teams, and they are welcome to participate as long as they play in the recreational league. The rosters will have to be signed by your recreational league president. No birth certificates are required as this should already be verified by the individual leagues. All registration forms for the league MUST be submitted together. Individual team registrations will not be accepted.

The program will include team rosters, team pictures, parent well wishes, advertisements and the pool and brackets game schedules. Individual ads can be purchased for teams or individuals. A rate sheet and contact information for those ads are included in this packet.

Team pictures are optional and must be purchased as a program ad. All program ads MUST arrive by 5 pm on June 22nd. Any pictures/payment arriving after this date will not be published. Ad purchases may be purchased online and by mail.

NO DOGS are allowed in the MUGS Softball Complex

We ask that you also observe all other rules for our facility such as:

- NO SKATEBOARDS, BICYLES, ROLLER BLADES, OR SKATES ALLOWED
- NO SMOKING/VAPING PERMITTED INSIDE COMPLEX
- NO HITTING OR THROWING INTO ANY FENCES
- BE AWARE OF SPECTATORS AND PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC
 WHILE WARMING UP
- NO ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION or INTOXICATION IN THE COMPLEX

ROSTERS

Each team shall have a 12-player roster for 8U, 10U and 12U. There are NO exceptions in these age divisions.

For 14U and 18U, roster must have a minimum of 11 players and a maximum of 12 players. Please see the 2019 All Star rules for additional information on the 14U and 18U divisions.

- The League, Organization or City name from which a team is entered must be prominently displayed on the player's uniform during all games.
- ACE (Achieve, Certify, and Educate) Coaching Certification will be required for all coaches. Coaches will be required to display their USA Softball ID Badge during tournament play. A current ACE certification card must be presented to the umpire at the plate prior to each game. Additionally, all adult volunteers that will be interacting with the players, either on the field or in the dugout, will be required to complete the USA Softball background check. These volunteers are also required to display their USA Softball ID badge during tournament play.

We hope you find this packet useful while planning your All Star trip. Please pay close attention to the deadlines. We will not be responsible for information (pictures, rosters, etc.) that is not included in the program due to missed deadlines on the *part* of the individual associations, advertisers or coaches. TOURNAMENT RULES

GENERAL RULES FOR ALL AGE GROUPS

- 1. Rosters in each age group shall consist of a minimum of 25% (+/- 2%, left to the discretion of the local league board) of registered players in that age group.
- 2. The League, Organization or City name from which a team is entered must be prominently displayed on the player's uniform during all games.
- 3. ACE (Achieve, Certify, Educate) Coaching Certification will be required for all coaches. Coaches will be required to display their USA Softball ID Badge during tournament play. A current ACE certification card must be presented to the umpire at the plate prior to each game. Additionally, all adult volunteers that will be interacting with the players, either on the field or in the dugout, will be required to complete the USA Softball background check. These volunteers are also required to display their USA Softball ID badge during tournament play.
- 4. Team rosters for 8U, 10U and 12U are required to have 12 players. Team Rosters for 14U, 16U and 18U must have a minimum of 11 players and a maximum of 12 players.
 - a. Once tournament begins, rosters cannot be changed. Each team may select one alternate at the discretion of each organization. If an alternate is chosen she may play in pool games only. If a league does not have the required number of players available to form a team, the league may go to a nearby town's league and pick up the necessary number of players needed. These pick-up players must have participated in league play and be approved by both league presidents.
- 5. Roster players must be listed on the team roster first. This will be in the 1-12 slots for 8U-12U; or 1-11 slots for 14U-18U teams electing to participate with the minimum number of players. If an alternate replaces a roster player (1 of the first 12 listed; or 1 of the first 11 players listed for 14U-18U teams electing to participate with the minimum number of players) that roster player is ineligible for the rest of the tournament. If the roster player enters a game after being declared ineligible, that game shall be a forfeit.
- 6. If a team does not have the required number of players (12 for 8U, 10U, 12U, and a minimum of 11/maximum of 12 for 14U, 16U, 18U), an out will be taken for each player not on the roster/lineup. There are NO exceptions to this rule.
- 7. No player will sit out more than one inning in a row.
- 8. Bat your entire lineup the entire game. If a player is absent, an out will be given for each player not present at their 'at bat' time.
- 9. International Tie Breaker will be used after time or innings expire.
- 10. Pool games will be 55 minute, dead stop time limit.
- 11. Bracket games will be one hour and twenty minutes including championship and if necessary games.
- 12. The tournament will supply each team with 2 balls to begin the tournament. Additional balls may be purchased as needed. All balls shall be ASA approved
- 13. When pitching, restrictions are in place, the following will apply:
 - a. Each coach will be allowed three trips per pitcher per game
 - b. A pitching change without a conference counts as a trip.
 - c. A pitching change between innings counts as a trip.
 - d. A defensive conference is a trip on the pitcher.
 - e. Pitcher outs are to be reviewed during the pre-game conference with the umpires. Pitcher outs can be verified at this time by reviewing the team's official scorebook or by other means as required.

- f. If the game goes into extra innings, the pitcher pitching the last out of the last inning will not be credited with any outs pitched in extra innings. For 10U, an extra inning begins with inning #6. For 12U-18U, and extra inning begins with #8. Play after time has expired does not necessarily count as an extra inning. If a pitching change is made during the extra innings, the outs are charged to the new pitcher. This only applies to extra innings, not time.
- g. If the pitcher exceeds her outs allowed to pitch, the penalty is she may not pitch for the next two games and the Head Coach is suspended for the next game. The last pitch she threw will be ruled an illegal pitch.
- h. There is no penalty for a pitcher exceeding her outs due to multiple out situations.
- i. If a team reaches the run limit without getting three outs, the pitcher in the circle when the last run scored is credited with the outs not actually earned.
- 14. Substitutions during an inning are not allowed except in the case of injury. The substitute may play any position including pitcher.
- 15. Pitcher's outs are cleared for the championship games. Pitcher's outs are carried over to the "if" game.
- 16. Run rules are as follows for all age groups:
 - 1. 15 after 3
 - 2. 10 after 4
 - 3. 8 after 5
 - 4. Once time has expired and a team is behind by more runs than they can score in their half of that inning, the game will be over by run rule.
- 17. Protest fee will be \$50 cash-if protest is lost, money stays with the tournament. Protests will be decided immediately. All protests must be made before the umpires have left the field at the end of the game.
- 18. Unless specified otherwise, the ASA Division "B" rules are in effect.
- 19. If it becomes necessary to shorten or cancel games due to inclement weather consolation games will be altered or canceled first.
- 20. Tournament Format will be:
 - a. 5 Game Guarantee consisting of 2 pool games and a Double Elimination Bracket with a Consolation Bracket
- 21. Awards shall be:
 - a. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place team and individual trophies.
 - b. Consolation winner team and individuals
 - c. Hosting Association may, but is not required, to give participation awards to all players
- 22. Entry fee shall be \$350 per team. Hosting organization will remit \$15 per team to Texas ASA to cover liability insurance.
- 23. Gate fee shall be \$250 per team, OR the hosting organization may choose to charge a gate fee per person of:
 - a. \$15 Tournament Pass
 - b. \$5 Day Pass
 - c. Ages 5 and under are free
- 24. All player ASA insurance fees, or other player/team insurance forms must be sent to Scott Stone or Freddie Ezell no later than June 1, 2019.

PROOF OF INSURANCE MUST BE PROVIDED FOR ALL PLAYERS AND/OR TEAMS

8 & UNDER

- 1. Base path will be 60 ft.
- 2. Pitching will be machine pitch. Pitching distance will be 35 ft. The speed of the machine will be set at 35 mph.
- 3. Adjustment of the pitching machine will be determined by both team coaches prior to the scheduled game start time. Any adjustment after the start of the game will be made at the umpire's discretion.
- 4. Play will be 10 players on defense. The 10th player (rover) must play in the outfield. All outfielders must start on the grass until the ball leaves the machine. No player except catcher may be positioned closer than 35 ft. from the batter at the time of the pitch. The pitcher must be in the circle in line with or behind the pitching rubber until the ball leaves the machine.
- 5. NO stealing NO sliding NO bunting.
- 6. Maximum of 6 pitches allowed. Three swinging strikes is an out.
- 7. Run limit is 5 per inning. Fifth inning run limit is 7 runs.
- 8. Infield fly and dropped 3rd strike rules do not apply.
- 9. When the pitcher has control of the ball inside the circle, and she is not making a play on a runner, play is to be stopped by the umpire. Runners who have not crossed the halfway mark between bases must return to the base last touched.
- 10. The coach will appoint a member of his or her coaching staff to run the machine for his or her batters. The coach feeding the machine can coach the batter until the ball leaves the machine. A 1st and 3 base coach shall be positioned in the coaching boxes and shall coach the batter and base runners.
- 11. Under no conditions may a runner steal a base. Each runner may leave the base when the ball leaves the machine, but the ball is dead if not hit, and she must return to her base without liability to be put out.
- 12. The coach pitcher will try to avoid interfering with the play after the ball has been hit. If, in the judgment of the umpire, the coach intentionally interferes with the play:
 - a. The ball is declared dead.
 - b. The batter is out.
- 13. If a ball is hit and remains too close to the machine to be played safely, the umpire will declare the ball dead.

10 & UNDER

- 1. Play with 10 players on defense. The 10th player (rover) must play in the outfield. All outfielders must start on the grass. Run limit is 5 runs per inning. Fifth inning run limit is 7 runs.
- 2. No dropped 3rd strike rule.
- 3. Infield fly rule is in effect.
- 4. Pitchers are limited to 15 outs per 2 game set.
- 5. Open bases in stealing.

12 & UNDER 14 & UNDER 18 & UNDER

- 1. Play with 9 players on defense.
- 2. Run limit is 7 runs per inning.
- 3. Dropped 3rd strike rule is in effect.
- 4. Pitchers are limited to 21 outs per 2 game set.
- 5. 14 & UNDER ONLY: PITCHING DISTANCE IS 43'. METAL CLEATS ARE ALLOWED

6. 18 & UNDER ONLY: PITCHING DISTANCE IS 43'. METAL CLEATS ARE ALLOWED

Pitcher's Outs

- 1. Any team against whom the violation of the Pitcher's out rule occurred, must protest the game within 10 minutes of that game's completion to the Tournament Director or member of the Tournament Executive Committee only.
 - a. If it is found that a violation did occur, the violating team will forfeit the game in which the violation occurred and the protesting team will be awarded a forfeit victory. The Head Coach of the offending team will be excluded from the field and/or dugout for the next game and the Pitcher in question will not be allowed to pitch the next game. The Pitcher will be allowed to play any and all other positions in that next game.
 - b. There will be no further protests or punishments against the violating team for this game in question.
- 2. If a team has violated the **Pitcher's Outs** rule, and that violation was NOT protested by the team against whom the violation occurred, the NEXT team whom the offending team plays, may lodge a protest prior to the next game.
 - a. This type of protest MUST be made to the Tournament Director or Member of the Tournament Executive Committee PRIOR to the start of the game. This type of protest can ONLY be made by the Head Coach of the very NEXT game the violating team is playing. NO team may protest a violation that occurred in game earlier in the brackets than immediately prior to their game, i.e., the violation occurred in game 2, only the team they face in game 3 may protest.
 - b. If a violation is found to have occurred, the Coach of the violating team will not be allowed on the field and/or dugout for the next 2 games after the violation game. The Pitcher in question will not be allowed to pitch in the next 2 games after the violation game. The pitcher will be allowed to play any and all other positions.

3. EMPHASIS

- a. Only 1 of these 2 types of protests may be lodged against a violating team, with Rule 1 carrying priority over Rule 2.
- b. Only the Head Coach may file a protest.
- c. All Protests must be made to the Tournament Director, or Member of Tournament Executive Committee.
- No protest will be heard that is not timely executed according to Rule 1 (within 10 minutes of the conclusion of the offending game) or Rule 2 (prior to the START of the next bracket game after the offending game).

CODE OF CONDUCT

COACH BEHAVIOR:

- 1. No coach will charge out of the dugout when questioning an umpire's decision. An act of this nature will result in immediate ejection from the game and the ballpark. Any action resulting in a warning or ejection from the game will result in a meeting with the appropriate All Star Tournament Official.
- 2. No team shall station a coach, player, or parent down the opposite baseline to give instructions to their players. This does not include the base coach.
- 3. Coaches will be responsible for the actions of their parents.
- 4. Unsportsmanlike conduct by any coach that is directed at the opposing players, coaches, or parents shall not be permitted. Same can be said for umpires and tournament officials.
- 5. Alcohol shall not be permitted at the ball fields in any form. This includes on the breath of any person while at the game.

PLAYER BEHAVIOR:

Players may chant or shout <u>positive</u> things to their teammates. Negative or unsportsmanlike comments directed to opposing players, coaches, or fellow teammates shall not be tolerated.

SPECTATOR BEHAVIOR:

Spectators should act in a sportsmanlike manner. Anyone attending the game is subject to the alcohol rules of the league and violation of this rule will be cause for immediate removal from the park area. Please promote a positive environment for the girls of this tournament. Any spectator in violation of this policy may be asked to leave the field area. Failure to do so could result in the game being stopped and a forfeit
