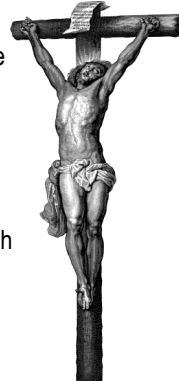
## A Note from our Pastor
