Well it's always wonderful, but if you really need to know before you come to the KYC check out the [Keuka Yacht Club weather station](#) on Weather Underground for current conditions. You might have noticed the station is on a pole at the end of the main dock. There is a display unit inside the Club near the bar.

Online you can also look back at conditions. Check out Sunday August 2nd. At 11:34am, the wind speed recorded was 9mph, at 11:49am it was 19mph and at 12:19pm it was 26mph. The high recorded at the KYC on Sunday was 33mph.

After unloading your car, please take it to the lot across the road to keep the access to the hoists clear. Be sure to respect the lake level Handicapped parking spots!

- Please stay outside and enjoy our expansive outdoor area.
