## ORDINANCE NO. 335

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 191 OF THE CITY OF WALTON, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WALTON, HARVEY COUNTY, KANSAS:

- Section 1. Section 107 (c) shall provide that there is hereby levied an animal tag fee upon the owner or harborer of each dog within the corporate limiteds of the City of Walton as follows:
- 1. Each neutered male or spayed female the sum of six dollars (6) for the license tag. A certificate of spaying or neutering signed by a licensed veretinarian must be presented when paying the fee to receive the lower rate.
- 2. For each unneutered male or unspayed female the sum of twenty dollars (\$20).
- 3. The license fee herein levied shall cover the period from June 1 through May 31 or part thereof each year. The license fee shall be due and paable on June 1 of each year. If the license fees are not payed with sixty (60) days of the due date, a penalty of twenty dollars (\$20) shall be added; provided, that new residents of the city or persons acquiring a dog or owning a dog that attains the age of registration after August 1 shall have thirty days (30) days in which to register the dog at the regular fee.
- 4. Any person who shall be convicted of violating this provision shall be punished by a fine of not more than two hundred (\$200). Each day that a violation of this provision occurs shall consitute a separate offense and shall be punishable hereunder as a separate violation.
- Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective and be in full force and effect after its adoption and publication in the official city newspaper.
