THE TOWN OF ARNAUDVILLE hereby abandons the section of St. Antoine Street (50' right of way) will be between +/-139.90' to 142' in length from the west right-of-way of LA Hwy 740, to the boundary line between La Junction Trailer Park and Frank Evans Meche.

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE AD VALOREM MILLAGE RATES FOR GENERAL ALIMONY AND WATERWORKS TO BE LEVIED ON ALL PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION BY THE TOWN OF ARNAUDVILLE FOR TAX YEAR 2024.

SECTION 1: BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Arnaudville, Louisiana, in regular and legal session convened, that the Town of Arnaudville of the Parish of St. Landry and St. Martin, Louisiana, in a public meeting held on July 23, 2024, which meeting was conducted in accordance with the Open Meetings Law and the additional requirements of Article XII, Section 3 of the Louisiana Constitution and R.S. 42:11 – 28 [R.S. 42:11, et seq.] that the following millage rate(s) be and they are hereby levied upon the dollar of each assessed valuation of all property which is subject to ad valorem taxation within said Town for the year 2024 for the purpose of raising revenue:

	<u>Millage Rate:</u>
General Alimony (5129 001 & 5139 001):	5.500 mills
Waterworks (5129 002 & 5139 002):	6.730 mills

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proper administrative officials of the Parish of St. Landry and St. Martin, State of Louisiana, be and they are hereby empowered, authorized, and directed to spread said taxes, as hereinabove set forth, upon the assessment roll of said Parish for the year 2024, and to make the collection of the taxes imposed for and on behalf of the taxing authority, according to law, and that the taxes herein levied shall become a permanent lien and privilege on all property subject to taxation as herein set forth, and collection thereof shall be enforceable in the manner provided by law.


