Guest speaker - Jacky Howell

"Create a Culture of Acceptance and Kindness in a Challenging World: It All Starts in Your Program!"

"This session looks at a variety of ways we can help young children grow and develop the social emotional skills of kindness and empathy to promote a sense of connectedness in our world today. Looking at current information and research on HOW to teach these skills from infancy to all ages will be discussed. Experiences and information from a variety of programs will be shared. Participants will have an opportunity to share what works in their programs. Resources and ideas will focus on teaching these skills in an interactive, lively format. Participants will leave with a wide variety of ideas they can use in their programs or classrooms."

Jacky Howell, MA., has been working in the field of early childhood education over 40 years. She received her Masters' in Human Development from Pacific Oaks College. She has been an early childhood teacher, assistant director, keynote presenter, workshop presenter as

well as an on-site consultant and mentor to early childhood programs throughout the DC Metropolitan area and beyond. She presented this same workshop at the NAEYC conference in Atlanta, Georgia in November 2017. In addition, she presented this topic as a webinar through Early Investigation Webinars. She is an author and has written a column for *Teaching Young Children*, articles for *Young Children* and co-authored a book published by NAEYC, *Rituals and Traditions: Fostering a Sense of Community in Preschool.*
