# The 17th Annual Ohio High School Invitational State "Kick-Off" Tournament! 

"New" Entry Requirements

This high school tournament is managed by the Ohio High School Bowling Program in conjunction with sponsorship and supervision by Westerville Central H.S. (D1) and Coldwater H.S. (D2). This tournament will observe the rules of participation and play established by the Ohio High School Athletic Association (OHSAA). Participation is by invitation only and an invitation to participate is offered to any 2020-2021 Division I or Division II OHSAA-registered school bowling team that meets at least one of the following entry requirements:

1. Participated in the 2019-2020 OHSAA D1 or D2 State Championship Tournament.
2. Placed 1st - 8th in a 2019-2020 OHSAA D1 or D2 District Tournament.
3. Placed 1st - 8th in a 2019-2020 OHSAA D1 or D2 Sectional Tournament.
4. Placed 1st -5th in their 2019-2020 D1 or D2 bowling conference, or, in the case where the bowling conference has multiple divisions, placed 1st-5th in their conference division. Teams that tied for 5th place in their conference or conference division standings are both invited to participate.
If a team eligible to participate elects not to accept an invitation, the invitation to participate is offered to the next school team(s) based on order of finish in any of the entry requirements noted above.

NOTE: It is the responsibility of the school coach to determine the team's eligibility to participate and to confirm the team's OHSAA 2020-2021 division (1 or 2).
Due to facility considerations, The maximum number of participating teams in each tournament is limited to sixty (60) and will be determined based on the postmark date of the paid entry, subject to maximum number of teams permitted by the State of Ohio and bowling center covid-19 safety policies (see Pg.3). First comefirst served. No unpaid entries will be accepted or reserved. Reservations to participate will NOT be accepted by telephone or E-mail. It is anticipated that this tournament will be an early "sell-out" again this season. Tournament management reserves the right to balance the boys \& girls fields with an even number of gender teams for lane assignment purposes.

Spectator admission of $\$ 7.00$ will be charged. Children age $6 \&$ under: no admission charge. Each team may admit a maximum of 8 uniformed bowlers and two (2) coaches at no charge. Tournament Proceeds go to the Ohio High School Bowling Program and the sponsoring H.S.

## Tournament Format

There are two (2) separate team divisions in each tournament: boys and girls. Five (5) participating bowlers per team. Team roster is limited to eight (8) bowlers. The format is the same for each division and tournament.
Qualifying Round: All teams will bowl three (3) regular games and two (2) Baker games on the same, preassigned lanes. Based on the total scores from the Qualifying Round, the top eight (8) or sixteen (16) teams in each division will advance to the Championship Round. The number of advancing teams dependent on the number of entries in a division and will be decided and announced by tournament management on site prior to the start of competition. All ties for advancing team positions will be broken by a 9th/10th frame roll-off.
Championship Round: The advancing teams in each division will be seeded in a single elimination, best of five (5) Baker game match play bracket. Teams will be seeded based on scores from the Qualifying Round. All ties in any Championship Round Baker game will be broken by a 9th/10th frame roll-off.
