

# TOWNSHIP/CITY HOUSEHOLD INCOME & ASSET STANDARDS TO ELIGIBLE FOR A POVERTY EXEMPTION

THE TOWNSHIP/CITY HAS ADOPTED THE FOLLOWING STANDARDS FOR THE **2026** YEAR:

2	\$ 21,150

FOR EACH ADDITIONAL PERSON	\$ 5,500

**THE ASSET THRESHOLD FOR THE TOWNSHIP/CITY IS \$28,000 FOR ONE PERSON LIVING IN THE HOUSEHOLD AND \$38,000 FOR TWO OR MORE PEOPLE LIVING IN THE HOUSEHOLD.**

EXAMPLES OF ASSETS ARE: (THIS IS NOT AN EXHAUSTIVE LIST):

- \* A SECOND HOME, LAND, VEHICLES (LARGER THAN THE "FOOTPRINT" FOR THE HOME)
- \* RECREATIONAL VEHICLES SUCH AS CAMPERS, BOATS AND ATV'S
- \* BUILDINGS OTHER THEN RESIDENCE
- \* JEWELRY, ARTWORK, ANTIQUES
- \* BANK ACCOUNTS (OVER \$5,000) OR STOCKS
- \* MONEY RECEIVED FROM THE SALE OF PROPERTY, STOCKS, BONDS, CAR OR HOME
- \* GIFTS, LOANS, LUMP-SUM INHERITANCES
- \* FEDERAL NON-CASH BENEFITS PROGRAM SUCH AS MEDICAID OR FOOD STAMPS
