

2021 PRSC Covid Guidelines



Executive Order No. 241 (2021) amended outdoor masking requirements. Individuals are no longer required to wear masks in these outdoor settings, though unvaccinated individuals are **strongly encouraged** to do so.

- 1. Face coverings are required in indoor settings.
- 2. Face coverings should NOT be worn in the water (increases the risk of drowning).
- 3. Hands should be washed frequently with soap and water.
- 4. Hand sanitizer that is at least 60% alcohol should be used if soap and water are not available.
- 5. Individuals should not touch their faces (especially eyes, nose, or mouth) with unwashed hands.
- 6. Individuals must stay home if they are sick.
- 7. Practice social distancing and avoid large gatherings.
- 8. Routine cleaning and disinfecting will be performed in a manner that promotes the safety of public and staff.
- 9. Staff and patrons who are sick or have recently had a close contact with a person with COVID-19 should stay home.
- 10. Separate entry and exit points to encourage everyone to move in one direction and avoid crowds.
- 11. We encourage you to bring your own play equipment (basketballs, soccer balls, volleyballs).
- 12. Restroom exhaust fans are functional and operating at full capacity when the building is occupied. These are on a timer during our operating hours.
