





Max Weight: N/A

Delivery Time: Typically 1-3 business days

TIP: Postcards are the lowest cost First-Class mail.

PRESORTED (FIRST-CLASS & MARKETING MAIL)

Presorting your mail can give you much lower postage rates. Group your mail by zip code so all mail pieces going to the same area are in the same bundle or tray.

FIRST-CLASS MAIL® (PRESORTED)

First-Class Presorted mail is typically used for personalized/unique mail, such as invoices and statements. Each mailing must contain at least 500 pieces. Delivery is typically 1-3 business days.

MARKETING MAIL (PRESORTED)

Marketing mail is typically used for general non-personal mail like advertising and catalogs. Each mailing must contain at least 200 pieces. Delivery is typically 2-9 business days.

General Requirements & Considerations for First-Class/Standard Presorted:

- Presorted mail requires first setting up an account with USPS®.
- All addresses should be checked against NCOA (move updates) and CASS (addressing standards).
- Presorting must conform to PAVE[™] standards.
- Mail must be dropped off at the Post Office or Business Mail Entry Unit (BMEU).



NONPROFIT

Nonprofit organizations can get significant postage discounts over the retail rate.

Nonprofit mail is sorted and prepared the same way as regular Marketing Mail, making it suitable for general mailings like event promotions. It is not applicable to personal/unique mail like invoices or statements.



Commercial Base Pricing

How to Get Commercial Base[®] Pricing Discounts

Commercial Base Pricing (CBP) is available when you use a postage meter or online postage service. For example, FP's PostBase™ meter combined with MailOne™ software offers CBP, which may enable you to quickly save enough in postage to recoup the equipment and software cost.

> TIP: Postage meters and online mail services can print IMpb labels at the commercial rate.

CBP = Commercial Base Pricing, available with meters/software or online postage.

1. Parcels are subject to a $0.20\ {\rm surcharge}$ if they are irregularly shaped, such as rolls, tubes, and triangles.

2. IMpb Noncompliant Fee: \$0.20 per piece.



RETAIL GROUND

Typical Use: Purchased at Post Office retail counter. Ideal for large packages. Includes tracking.

Max Weight: 70 lbs

Delivery Time: Typically 2-8 days.

RETAIL GROUND RATES

Retail Ground prices range from **\$7.35 to \$136.17** depending on weight and destination zone. For detailed price per weight/zone chart see **USPS Notice 123**.

Retail Pricing

What is Retail Ground?

USPS Retail Ground[®] is primarily intended for single-piece mailings which consist of any mailable matter that is not required to be mailed as First-Class Mail[®] and includes USPS Tracking[®] at no additional charge. It is commonly used for gifts and merchandise.

It is generally presented at a USPS retail service counter where USPS Tracking service can be initiated.

Prices are based on the zone (distance from origin to destination) and the weight of the parcel. While any mailable matter not required to be mailed as First-Class Mail is permitted to Zones 5-8, Zones 1-4 items are limited to mailable hazardous materials, live animals, and other items required to be shipped by ground.

TIP: Choose Retail Ground for occasional large packages with "less-than-urgent" delivery.



PARCEL SELECT GROUND

Typical Use: Low cost option for ground shipping medium-large size packages entered in bulk. Includes tracking.

Max Weight: 70 lbs

Delivery Time: Typically 2-8 days.

PARCEL SELECT RATES

Parcel Select[®] prices range from **\$6.85 to \$127.33** depending on weight and destination zone.

Parcel Select is a commercial service (similar to Commercial Base® Pricing) that is slightly less costly than its Retail counterpart (Retail Ground).

* IMpb Noncompliant Fee \$0.20 per piece.

For parcels that measure in combined length and girth more than 108 inches but not more than 130 inches, use oversized prices, regardless of weight, based on the applicable zone. Oversized prices range from **\$74.73 to \$196.61

Dimensions

At least 3 inches high x 6 inches long x 1/4 inch thick.

Maximum 108 inches in length + girth combined (up to 130 inches with additional fee).

Maximum weight 70 lbs

TIP: Choose Parcel Select when cost is more important than delivery time.





Print - Books, manuscripts, printed music, printed educational material, medical information

Recorded Media - Film, sound recordings

LIBRARY MAIL

USPS defines Library Mail as any of the following sent to or from a school, college, university, public library, museum, herbarium, or nonprofit organization:

Print - Books, printed music, bound academic papers, periodicals

Recorded Media - Sound recordings


MAILER'S GLOSSARY

- 3-Digit, 5-Digit Automation Mail is presorted by the first 3 digits or 5 digits of recipient zip codes.
- Automated Area Distribution Center (AADC) A USPS $^{\circ}$ distribution center that scans and processes automation-compatible mail.
- Automation Mail class for mail that can be scanned and processed by USPS® automation equipment. (See Machinable below.)
- Carrier Route Presort Mail Discounted mail sorted by carrier routes. (See Enhanced Carrier Route below.)
- Coding Accuracy Support System (CASS) A USPS $^{\circ}$ electronic service that verifies the syntax and accuracy of addresses.
- Certified Mail[®] USPS[®] extra service for First-Class and Priority Mail[®] that provides the sender with a receipt at the time of mailing
- Commercial Base[®] Pricing (CBP) Discounted postage pricing offered by USPS online, PC postage, and some postage meters/software.
- Dimensional (Dim) Weighting Postage price for Priority Mail packages, addressed to zones 5-8, that exceed one cubic foot (1,728 cubic inches) are charged postage based on the actual weight or the dimensional weight, whichever is greater.
- Direct Mail Advertising and promotional mail delivered to potential customers (e.g. brochures, catalogs, postcards, newsletters and sales letters).
- Enhanced Carrier Route (ECR) A type of Carrier Route Presort Mail (see above) that is automation compatible and sorted by carrier route walk sequence.
- First-Class Mail[®] (FCM) A collection of letter, flat, and lightweight parcel subclasses, typically delivered within 1-3 business days.
- Flat Legacy USPS® term for a large envelope.
- Franking Machine European term for postage meter.
- Indicia An imprint that represents U.S. postage printed by an authorized postage meter.
- Information Based Indicia (IBI) refers to a legacy type of postage meter imprint (indicia) that contains an encrypted 2-D data matrix barcode combined with human readable postage information that conforms to February 2000 performance criteria.
- Intelligent Mail Indicia (IMI) refers to the most current type of postage meter imprint (indicia) that contains an encrypted 2-D data matrix barcode combined with human readable postage information that conforms to March 2013 performance criteria.

- IMpb (Intelligent Mail® Package Barcode) a tracking barcode on a USPS® shipping label for packages.
- Letter A message to a particular person, written on a mailpiece no larger than 11½"x6%"x¼", typically enclosed in an envelope.
- Library Mail A package service mail class intended for media items (e.g. books, documents and recordings) sent between educational institutions.
- Machinable Mail that is compatible with USPS automated scanning & processing equipment. (See Automation above.)
- Media Mail[®] A package service mail class intended for non-promotional media (e.g. books, documents and recordings).
- Metered Mail Mail printed with an indicia from an authorized postage meter provider.
- National Change of Address (NCOA) A USPS database containing U.S. resident changes of address. Can be accessed electronically via the National Change of Address Linkage System to correct addresses before printing them.
- Nonprofit Mail A set of discounted mail rates available to qualifying non-profit organizations.
- Package/Parcel A mailpiece larger than a letter or flat, typically (but not necessarily) a box.
- Permit Imprint a pre-printed postage indicia containing the mailing permit number that represents postage paid in advance from a USPS deposit account for "bulk" mailing.
- Presorted Mail A set of postage discounts based on sorting mail prior to handing off to the post office, usually requiring at least 200 or 500 pieces per mailing.
- Registered Mail An extra service intended for very valuable mailpieces. In addition to proof of mailing and delivery, provides documented chain of custody.
- Return Receipt An extra service that provides sender with proof of delivery, including recipient signature for items that don't come with USPS Tracking[®].
- Signature Confirmation^M An extra service that requires recipient's signature, which is available as a record for the sender.
- Standard (Bulk) Mail A class of commercial mail with postage discount intended for mailings of at least 200 identical mailpieces (e.g. catalogs, advertising flyers, newsletters).
- Zones Postal zones are price categories based on origin and destination zip codes. Prices trend higher with longer distances and more rural origin and/or destination locations.
