### MEETING MINUTES FROM SEPTEMBER

The River City Cruisers Car Club meeting was held at the Hermann city park on September 24, 2019 with 21 members present. The meeting was called to order by President Doug Smith and Lynn Mead reported a balance of \$8023.28.

The meeting started off with going over the car show. We had 70 cars for the car show and 16 club cars. Not too bad for a rainy morning. Doug Smith thanked everyone for pulling together and relocating the show to the high school at the last minute. We couldn't have pulled it off without everyone's help.

Here is a "big picture" on the expenses/income (Lynn has a full breakdown on expenses/income if anyone is interested).

- \* Registration—\$1335 income
- \* Food—\$1050.50 income with \$739.10 expenses for a profit of \$311.40
- \* Trophies—\$2350 sponsorship with \$1321.86 expenses for a profit of \$1028.14
- \* T-shirts—\$1100 sponsorship plus \$658 sales with cost of \$1312.71 for a profit of \$445.29
- \* Quilt—\$177 income with \$45 expense for a profit of \$132
- \* 50/50—\$496 income (someone donated \$100 back)
- \* Miscellaneous—\$687.41 expenses

Even though it was a rainy morning and not as many cars, the car show still brought in a total profit of \$1392.08.

Lynn drafted a letter to send to all past participants thanking them for their participation and that we would not be doing the 'Car Show in the Park' next year. This brought up discussion on what we will do. Randy Frye mentioned if the Fire Dept. would be interested in organizing the show. Randy took action to contact them to see if they were interested. We will discuss ideas/options (big or small) for next year at the Christmas dinner.
