

ORDINANCE 744.

An Ordinance providing for the issuing of bonds of the City of Garnett, Anderson County, Kansas, for the purpose of improving the electric lighting and water plant now owned by said city, and furnishing lights and power and water to the inhabitants of the city of Garnett, Kansas, to the amount of Sixty-five Thousand (\$65,000.00) dollars, authorized at a special election, duly called and held in said city, in all respects in accordance with the statutes of the State of Kansas governing the same, on the 4th day of June, 1918.

WHEREAS at a special election duly called and held in the City of Garnett, Anderson County, Kansas, in all respects in accordance with the statutes of the State of Kansas in relation thereto on the 4th day of June A.D. 1918, at which more than a majority of the qualified electors, voting <sup>said</sup> at a special election, voted in favor of the proposition to authorize the Board of Commissioners of said city of Garnett, to issue the bonds of said city, to the amount of Sixty-five Thousand (\$65,000.00) dollars for the purpose of providing funds with which to improve the electric lighting and water plant now owned and operated by said city and furnish lights and power and water to the inhabitants of the city of Garnett, Kansas, now therefore

Be it ordained by the Mayor and board of Commissioners of the City of Garnett, Kansas:

Section 1. That the negotiable coupon bonds of the city of Garnett, Kansas, to the aggregate amount of Sixty-five thousand (\$65,000.00) dollars be and the same are hereby authorized and ordered to be issued, for the purpose of providing funds to improve the electric lighting and water plant now owned and operated by said city, and furnish lights and power and water to the inhabitants of said city of Garnett, Kansas,. Said bonds shall bear the date of July 1st, 1918, and shall be ~~in~~ Sixty five in number and numbered from one (1) to Sixty five (<sup>65</sup>) inclusive and of the denomination of One thousand (1000.00); and ~~payable~~ shall be due and payable absolutely twenty-five years from the date thereof, said bonds shall bear interest at the rate of Five (<sup>5</sup>) per cent per annum payable semiannually on the 1st days of January and July in each year, which interest payments shall be evidenced by proper coupons attached to each bond and



both principal and interest shall be payable at the <sup>Office of the</sup> Treasurer of the  
State of Kansas.

Section 2. That the said bonds and coupons shall be in the following forms respectively to wit:


Know all men by these presents : That the City of Garnett, in the county Anderson and State of Kansas, acknowledges itself to owe, and for value received hereby promises to pay to bearer, the sum of One Thousand and no/100 (\$1000<sup>00</sup>) dollars lawful money of the United States of America on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July 1918, together with interest on said sum from the date hereof until paid, at the rate of Five (5%) percent per annum, payable semi-annually on the first days of January and July in each year upon presentation and surrender of the interest coupons hereto attached as they severally become due; both principal and interest payable in lawful money of the United States of America at the Fiscal Agency of the State of Kansas in the City of Topeka, in the State of Kansas. And for the prompt payment of this bond, with interest as aforesaid at maturity, the full faith and credit of said city are here irrevocably pledged.


This bond is issued by the said city for the purpose of providing funds with which to pay for the improvement of the electric lighting and water plant now owned by said city, and furnishing lights and power and water to the inhabitants of said city, and are authorized by more than a majority of the qualified electors of the said city voting at an election duly called <sup>A.D.</sup> and held therein said city on the 4th day of June, 1918, and in all respects in full compliance with the provisions of an act of the Legislature of the State of Kansas entitled "An act authorizing certain cities to issue bonds for natural gas, water, light and heating purposes;" approved March 4th, 1905 and as amended by chapter 75 of the Laws of 1911, as amended by chapters 75 and 123 of the Laws of 1913; and of an Ordinance duly passed by the Board of Commissioners of the said city.



AND IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED AND RECITED that all acts and conditions and things required by the Laws of the State of Kansas to be done precedent to and in the issue of this bond have been properly done, happened and been ~~been~~ performed in regular and due form and time as required by law, and that the total indebtedness of said city, including this bond does not exceed any constitutional or statutory limitation.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, the said city of Garnett, by its Board of Commissioners, has caused its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and this bond to be signed by its Mayor and attested by its city clerk and each of the coupons attached to be executed by the original or lithographed fac simile signatures of said Mayor and City Clerk, this 1st day of July 1918.

Section 4. That after said bonds shall be so executed and registered  
they shall be delivered to the purchaser thereof, for the contract price,  
and all proceeds derived from such sale shall be placed in a special fund,  
to be used solely for the purpose for which said bonds recite they are being  
issued.

Section 5. That the Mayor and board of Commissioners of said city of  
Garnett, shall annually levy on all the taxable property, real, personal,  
or mixed, <sup>within</sup> ~~xxxx~~ the corporate limit of said city, such taxes in addition  
to all other city taxes, as shall be sufficient to raise the amount  
required to raise the interest on the bonds issued hereunder when and as

~~when and under~~ as the same becomes due and also liquidate the principal thereof at maturity.

Section 6. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the time required by law from its passage and approval and publication in the official paper of said city.
