## ORDINANCE 744.

An Ordinance providing for the issuing of bonds of the City of Garnett, Anderson County, Kansas, for the purpose of improving the electric lighting and water plant now owned by said city, and furnishing lights and power and water to the inhabitants of the city of Garnett, Kansas, to the amount of Sixty-five Thousand (\$65,000.00) dollars, authorized at a special election, duly called and held in said city, in all respects in accordance with the statutes of the State of Kansas governing the same, on the 4th day of June, 1918.

WHEREAS at a special election duly called and held in the City of Garnett, Anderson County, Kansas, in all respects in accordance with the statutes of the States of Kansas in relation thereto on the 4th day of June A.D., 2918, at which more than a majority of the qualified electors, voting said at a special election, voted in favor of the proposition to authorize the Board of Commissioners of said city of Garnett, to issue the bonds of said city, to the amount of Sixty-five Thousand (\$65,000.00) dollars for the purpose of providing funds withwhich to to improve the electric lighting and water plant now owned and operated by said city and furnish lights and power and water to the inhabitants of the city of Garnett, Kansas, now therefore

X Be it ordained by the Mayor and board of Commissioners of the City of Garnett, Kansas:

Section 1. That the negotiable coupon bonds of the city of Garnett, Kansas, to the aggregate amount of Sixty-five thousand (\$65,000.00) dollars be and the same are hereby authorized and ordered to be issued, for the purpose of providing funds to improve the electric lighting and water plant now owned and operated by said city, and furnish lights and power and water to the inhabitants of said cityof Garnett, Kansas,. Said bonds shall bear the date of fuly 100 ,1918, and shall be in Lingfur in number and numbered from one (1) to Lixty ful (6) inclusive and of the denominat tion of Canthausand (Normal); and saying shall be due and payable absolutely twenty-five years from the date thereof, said bonds shall bear interest at the rate of Fine (6) per cent per annum payable semiannually on the 10th days of January and fully in each year, which interest payments shall be evidenced by proper coupons attached to each bond and

both principal and interest shall be payable at the Irecasurer of the state of Kausas.

Section 2. That the said bonds and coupons shall be in the following forms respectively towit:

Anderson and State of Kansas, acknowledges itself to owe, and for falue received hereby promises to pay to bearer, the sum of Our Thousand and Major (10000) dollars lawful money of the United States of America on the 1st day of fully 1943, together with interest on said sum from the date hereof untilly paid, at the rate of fine (5% percent per annum, payable semi-annually on the first days of fathering and for the each year upon presentation and surrender of the interest coupons hereto attached as they severally become due; both principal and interest payable in lawful money of the United States of America at the Fiscal Agency of the State of Kansas in the City of Topeka, in the State of Kansas. And for the prompt payment of this bond, with interest as aforesaid at maturity, the full faith and credit of said city are here irrevocably pledged.

This bond is issued by the said city for the purpose of providing funds with which to pay for the improvement of the electric lighting and water plant now owned by said city, and furnishing lights and power and water to the inhabitants of said city, and are authorized by more than a majority of the qualified electors of the said city voting at an election duly called and held therein said city on the 4th day of June, 1918, and in all respects in full compliance with the provisions of an act of the Lesislature of the State of Kansas entitled " An act authorizing certain cities to issue bonds for natural gas, water, light and heating purposes; " approved March 4th, 1905 and as amended by chapter 75 of the Laws of 1911, as amended by chapters 75 and 123 of the Laws of 1913; and of an Ordinance duly passed by the Board of Commissioners of the said city.

and things required by the Laws of the State of Kansas to be done precedent to and in the issue of this bond have been properly done, happened and been been performed in regular and due form and time as required by law, and that the total indebtedness of said city, including this bond does not exceed any constitutional or statutory limitation.
