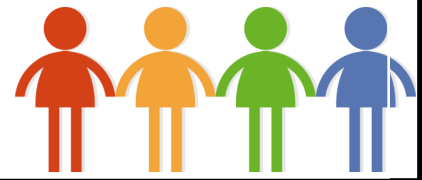

On **Tuesday, February 20, 2018, from 1:00-3:30 PM**, a representative of the Suncoast Professional Firefighters and Paramedics Charitable Foundation will be presenting a complete SAFE HEARTS class right here in our Recreation Center.
