THE NEW (FOR NOW) NORMAL AT THE KYC:

Here's a quick review if you haven't been to the Club yet this year (Phase 3 update as of 6/12):

- You may enjoy your food and beverage on the lawn *and at limited tables* in the Clubhouse. (do not add tables or chairs)
- **Face masks are still required** inside the Club, but may be removed *while* seated at your table
- Maintain 6' social distancing when not seated
- Remember to wash hands (or use the hand sanitizing stations located near exit) frequently
- Stay away if you aren't feeling well

Food:

- Entrance for food will be via the north door.
- Menu available at North Door for review.
- Please take care to throw all of your to go packaging in the proper disposal containers located at the main and north doors. It is important that we keep our area clean!

Bar:

- Entrance for beverage will be via the main door.
- Be aware of the marked areas to properly social distance.
- Canned beer/bottles of wine/plastic glasses of wine/ limited amount of mixed drinks available to go.
- Also available "buckets of beer"
- Price list on the door for you to review before entering the clubhouse and at the bar.

OUR FLAG

The National Flag Code was created under the auspices of the American Legion in 1923 and was signed into law on June 22, 1942. Title 4 of the United States Code is the guide for all handling and display of the Stars and Stripes.

The KYC’s worn flag was handed over to Brent Penwarden IV, who will ensure that the flag is respectfully retired. Aside from the Boy Scouts, other patriotic organizations such as the American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars, and Girl Scouts will properly retire an American flag when it is no longer a fitting emblem for display.
