

Stickman No. 33 Puzzlebox (The Hexagram)



Stickman Hexagram Puzzleboxes (No. 33) were designed by artist Robert Yarger, and crafted by apprentice Richard Jenkins out of quality jatoba and maple. Hexagram puzzles are of a somewhat modest complexity to solve, at least compared to most Stickman Puzzles, but they still require a minimum of 4 clever steps to access its single hidden compartment.

Puzzles measure roughly 4" x 1.5", and are stamped with the Stickman hallmark. They come with their own 4-page fully illustrated instruction book, and are limited in edition to 40 completed pieces.
