





This grant is ending so take advantage of the costs being waived.

Who must complete Live Scan Fingerprinting with GSGLA?

- Service Unit Managers
- Troop Leaders
- Volunteers and Event Staff that attend an overnight event as part of the adult/girl ratio
- Event Volunteers at events that are hosting girls for two days within one month (example: Day Camp)
- Live Scan fingerprinting cannot be shared so even if you have a live scan with your job or other organization, you must complete it with GSGLA as well.
- Volunteers will not need to live scan again as long as membership is maintained each year.








