Safety Notes * Please Read

Here are a few suggestions to help with that.

1. Bees are attracted to food of any kind. Please be careful with open containers like sodas and such. Please cover your containers or drink from a paper cup. We know this from a very bad experience.
2. Please **KEEP YOU DOGS ON LEASH** UNLESS YOU ARE PARTICIPATING IN AN EVENT THAT IS INSIDE FENCING. We are fenced around the property, but with travel in and out, the gate could be open. This road, is very busy.
3. No dogs nose to nose. It is very easy to be in a conversation and in a split minute the dogs could get into trouble with who is boss. If your dog needs his own space please use a red ribbon or scarf available at the registration desk.
4. There are deer, rabbits, and other types of droppings on the property. Try to avoid the dogs sampling it for their health.
5. **WATCH** your step. The ground is very uneven with large ruts, holes, stumps, plus tree roots below and on top of the ground.
6. Please keep your speed down to 5 miles per hour on the driveway, when entering or leaving, for your dog’s safety and dust control.
