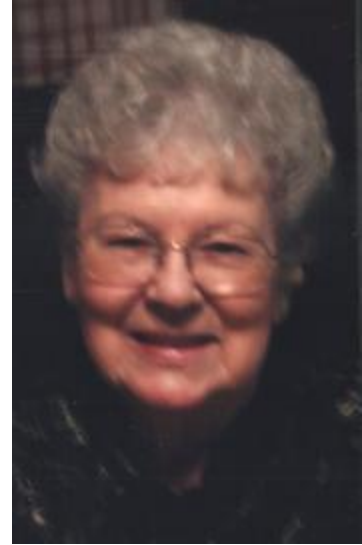


## Shirley L. Krueger

(July 22, 1924 - May 2, 2013)

Shirley L. Krueger, age 88 of Lake Twp. went home to be with her Lord, Thursday evening, May 2, at Huron Medical Center.

She was born July 22, 1924 in Detroit to the late Fritz and Gertrude (Lindenberg) Swanquist and graduated from Grosse Pointe High School in 1942. On June 2, 1945, she was united in marriage to Gordon J. Krueger in Napoleon, OH. They lived in Port Huron until 1948 then moved to Detroit, where she worked at Prudential Life Insurance Company. Shirley loved living on the bay, watching the sunset and taking pictures all of the time.
