* Concern was voiced about the trash that accumulates in the ravine/ditch. We set a volunteer clean up date for May5th at 10 AM with a rain date the next week. We also have that on the long range list of projects to fund for clean-up.

* Dog poop not being cleaned up and dogs seen running loose.
