





The Word of God Alive:

Discussing the Readings with your children



Why is sharing a meal with your family so important?

Today we celebrate the

Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. In the Gospel, Jesus feeds a large crowd. Jesus had been teaching all day. The disciples tell Jesus to send the crowd away so they can get food. Jesus tells the disciples, " Give them some food yourself." The disciples tell Jesus there are only two fish and five loaves of bread, clearly not enough to feed such a large crowd. Jesus takes the food, blesses it and the food is given to the crowd. It is a miracle that there is more than enough food for everyone, with twelve baskets of food leftover.

This story reminds us that we can trust God to provide for our needs. What God give us, nourishes us not only physically but also spiritually.

At Mass, our earthly offerings of bread and wine are

sanctified, or made holy, by the Holy Spirit to become the Body and Blood of Christ. Jesus Christ is truly present in the Eucharist. When we receive the Eucharist, we receive Jesus himself. He nourished us spiritually. The Eucharist strengthens us to live as



disciples, to do the work of Jesus in the world.


The next potluck will be Sunday, July 20th following the 11am Mass.
