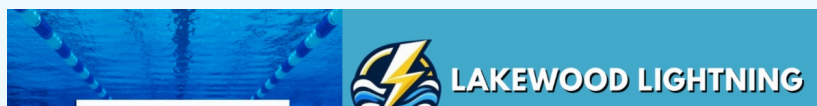

Disturbance Other:

13000 Elmington Dr. – Deputies responded to location in reference to a verbal disturbance over parking issues. An investigation was completed.

14200 Lakewood Forest Dr. – Deputies responded to location in reference to a disturbance other, where it was reported by the complainant that he saw an unknown person with a pistol coming towards his house and discharged his pistol in defense. The unknown person left the location.

12900 Marron Dr. – DWI - Deputies responded to location in reference to a vehicle parked on their lawn, where it was determined the driver was intoxicated and placed into custody for DWI.
