While this is a fun time of year, with lots of holy days/holidays, it can also be stressful and anxiety-producing. With the longer nights and rainy days, depression can also tug at our hearts. If you need to talk, feel sad, or grieve with someone, I am around.

One of the things I try to do in these Seasons of Advent and Christmas is set the bar low for my expectations. Family gatherings, with meals and gift-giving, are exciting and bring great pleasure. But it can also be a trying time, what with family dynamics, religion and politics all coming into play.

Someone once jokingly said it was okay to talk about religion and politics at family gatherings because it helps you to shorten the list of gifts you have to buy and saves you money. I, however, have done my best to avoid those topics.

This short service will not be broadcast or livestreamed, to provide confidentiality to those attending.

Finally, remember that joy is life, love, and creativity, even in the midst of sorrow and sadness. It is not the same as happiness or cheerfulness. In the Christian faith we rejoice at the Incarnation, even as we pray for the full realization of the Reign of God in Christ at the End of Time.
