#### **Federal Flood & Disaster Funding Available Through Cal OES**

The Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) has announced the availability of approximately \$289 million nationwide for local projects through two federal grant programs: 2016 [Pre-Disaster Mitigation](#) (PDM) and [Flood Mitigation Assistance](#) (FMA). Both of these programs are part of FEMA's Hazard Mitigation Assistance (HMA) program which provides funding for activities that reduce disaster losses and protect life and property. Local agencies are considered sub-applicants and must apply for the FEMA funding through [Cal OES](#).

#### **California Infrastructure Symposium Focusing on Water and Transportation**

Sacramento is hosting the annual [infrastructure conference](#) and focusing on transportation and water issues, including flood control. It's an all day event starting with a 7:30 am continental breakfast and ending with an awards dinner closing it out at 9:00 p.m. [Water workshops](#) are divided into four broad topics: 1) Flood Control; 2) Infrastructure Resilience; 3) Sustainability; and 4) Water Bond. These discussions will cover many issues from Sites Reservoir to local vision for flood control.
