The Aurora Colony Flea is a monthly sale with vendors carrying anything and everything: antiques, collectibles, furniture, handmade crafts and general household treasures. The monthly sales will run the first Saturday, September through May, with a possible special sale in August.

Vendors will rent 8' tables and the space around and under them. Tables and chairs will be provided. In order to maintain a diversity of vendors and product selection, management reserves the right to limit vendors to a maximum of three tables in heavily attended months. Vendor spots will be assigned as they enter into agreement with management. *Preferences will be given to those who commit to multiple sales.*

Vendors may set-up Friday afternoon from 4pm to 7pm and at 7am on the market day. The sale will be open from 9am to 4pm. **Packing before 4pm is not allowed.** All vendors must be at the sale prior to opening and someone must be available at all times during the sale. Vendors will leave their space in as-found condition. Vendors will act as their own cashier.

Vendors are required to park their vehicles away from the building after unloading and to not move vehicles closer before they are ready to reload. It is a common complaint of event attendees that parking is unavailable. We do not want possible attendees to bypass our sale because we, the vendors, have taken all the good parking spaces. Also, it is a common complaint of event vendors that other vendors 'camp-out' in the prime loading spaces before they are ready to load. **Vendors are asked to pack their spaces first before moving their vehicle closer to the building for loading.**

All caution will be made in an effort to keep the site secure. However, vendors agree that Red Dog Events LLC, the event manager, nor the venue should be held responsible or financially liable for any personal injury, damaged or stolen merchandise or personal property, or losses of any kind. The vendors assume all liability for loss or damage to the venue property and waive any claim against above mentioned parties.

Management has the right to revoke spaces and cancel reservations. Items sold must be in compliance with local laws and ordinances. Management takes no responsibility for item validity or the vendors' legal right to sell. Vendors shall not operate in a discourteous unprofessional manner, sell prohibited items including firearms, pornographic material, food, drinks, items violating trademark regulations or any other item found objectionable by management. *Mass produced or direct sales products as sold by representative, ie: Scentsy, Lularoe, etc, will be allowed at a limit of 10% of total table rentals.*

Kathy Jacoby will run and manage the sale including all communication with vendors, set up and tear down on the days of the sale and collecting all payments. The sale will be advertised in various printed and digital forms such as: local newspapers, social media, flea market portals, retail posters, postcards, street signage, etc. Vendors are encouraged to help with promotion by distributing marketing material, i.e. postcards, flyers, posters, etc. A pdf flyer is available for mailing list distribution.

Space fee is required with the return of the application.

Vendors committing to three or more markets may submit a 50% deposit rather than the entire fee.
