# Kittitas County Prehospital Care Protocols

Subject: LIDOCAINE (XYLOCAINE)

#### **ACTION:**

Suppresses ventricular ectopy activity, increases ventricular fibrillation threshold, reduces velocity of

electrical impulses through conduction system.

# **INDICATIONS:**

Symptomatic, ventricular tachycardia, ventricular fibrillation.

### **CONTRAINDICATIONS:**

High degree heart blocks, PVC's in conjunction with bradycardia.

#### PRECAUTIONS:

Dosage should not exceed 300 mg/hour, monitor for CNS toxicity, bolus should be followed by an  $\,$ 

infusion.

#### **SIDE EFFECTS:**

Anxiety, nausea, convulsions, widening of QRS.

### DOSAGE:

Bolus: Initial <u>1 mg/kg</u> IN THE STABLE PATIENT followed by one-half the initial dose every 8-10

minutes, 1.5 mg/kg IN THE UNSTABLE PATIENT, not to exceed 3 mg/kg total dose.

IV Infusion: 2-4 mg/minute (2 grams in 500 mL D5W)

#### **ROUTE:**

IV push and IV drip.

1 mg/kg
