

Curriculum

Our dance curriculum is based on a 32-week program. Classes begin on Thursday, September 5th and end with our annual Spring Recitals in May. The first third of the year, dancers will focus on proper technique and skills; in December we begin winter show choreography and rehearsals for the January performance; in February instructors will announce spring recital songs and begin choreography in class.

Monthly Tuition

Monthly installment payments are for class tuition:

30 minute class = \$35.00/month

45 minute class = \$44.00/month

1 hour class = \$54.00/month

1.25 hour class = \$64.00/month

1.5 hour class = \$74.00/month

- J Payment is due by the 1st of every month and is the same regardless of how many classes there are in a month. A student is not registered until the first payment is made in full.
- J All payments are made electronically. After your initial monthly payment with registration remaining monthly installments will be run automatically October - May.
- J Payments are non-transferable and non-refundable. A \$20 late fee is assessed for all payments received after the 8th of the month. DE has the right to suspend a student if payments are delinquent.
- J Statements/reminders are not sent. Students will not be allowed in class & costumes will not be distributed if accounts are past due.
- J A charge of \$25/dancer/change will be automatically charged for class changes made after September 1.
- J There will be no refunds for missed classes or dropping without following our drop policy.
- J No refunds for missed classes, family vacations, or classes cancelled due to things that are out of our control such as inclement weather or power outages. Students are welcomed to attend a similar level class as a make-up lesson.
- J No refunds for performance costs after December 1.
- J If it becomes necessary to pursue collection of any past due account balance through outside sources all reasonable collection costs, attorney fees, court costs, and contingency fees will also be added to the outstanding balance.
- J DE has the right to withhold distribution of costumes and/or prohibit a student from participating in performances if the account is past due.

Registration Fee

An annual \$30 per family registration fee is due with your initial registration payment of the school year season.

Discounts

Dancers taking more than one class will receive 5% off each additional class each month (discount taken on lesser amount).

Family Member Discounts occur when students from the same immediate family enroll in classes. We will discount 5% from the lowest tuition amount for the 2nd & additional dancers.

Performance Fees

All students will participate in Winter Shows in January and Spring Recitals in May. Performances include the following fees:

- J SPRING RECITALS (Due November 15th):

Payments can be divided into 3 payments due the 1st of Sept, Oct, Nov

Preschool—Gr 3 = \$90 first class, \$55 each additional class

Grades 4-Adults = \$100 first class, \$75 each additional class

Dancers must have the appropriate color and style of tights and shoes. Performance fees includes costume purchase (costumes are yours to keep after shows), recital tshirt, digital download of all shows and production costs.

- J WINTER SHOWS (Due December 15th):

Preschool—K1 = \$58/dancer

Grade 2-5 = \$72.00/dancer

Grade 6-12 = \$97/dancer

Cast = \$93/dancer

DE rents out most costumes and there are additional rehearsals on Saturdays (Sundays if in grade 6-12 cast). Dancers must have the appropriate color and style of tights and shoes. The Winter Show performance fee includes costume rental, winter show tshirt, digital download of all shows and production costs.

Paying Your Bill

By registering for class, you automatically sign-up for AutoPay. Your monthly tuition installment will be deducted on the 1st of every month using the credit card on file. Any account more than 30-days past due will be processed for the full amount. Your balance and transactions are available through your Parent Portal. You can access this at any time to view or print statements and receipts and change your preferred payment method. If you wish to pay your bill prior to AutoPay:

1. **Pay Online:** Login to your Parent Portal to make a one-time payment before the 1st of the month.
2. **Pay at DE:** email ali@danceendeavors.com to make a payment by cash or check before the 1st of the month.

Drop a Class

To drop a DE class, you will need to fill out a DROP FORM. A drop cannot be processed until the form is submitted. We will no longer accept drops via phone calls/emails. Contact ali@danceendeavors.com to request a drop form. We require a minimum of FIVE DAYS to process class drops before the 1st of the month to avoid AutoPay.

- J You are responsible for tuition during the month you drop.
- J The date on your drop form will be your last month of tuition.
- J If you drop on the 2nd, you will still pay that month's installment, and are able to attend classes that month. This gives us time to fill the open spot in the class.
- J We will not pro-rate monthly installments for drops. If you can only attend one class in the month and drop, you will still pay the full installment.
- J The annual (\$30/family) registration fee is non-refundable.
- J If you are dropping after November 15th there are no refunds on the spring recital performance fees (due November 15th)
- J If you are dropping after December 15th, there are no returns/refunds on winter show performance fees (due December 15th).
- J We will notify you when your costume is ready for pick-up.

Rescheduling and Substitution

DE reserves the right to provide a substitute teacher if the regular teacher is ill or is otherwise unable to teach. DE reserves the right to reschedule or combine classes.

Class Drop-Off and Observation

- J You are not required to stay, but if you leave please pick up your child ON TIME! Each studio has a viewing window for observation during classes. It is imperative that distractions be kept to a minimum for our dancers so parents and other students are not allowed in the studio during class.

Inclement Weather

If the weather is questionable, check your email and our website for cancellations. You may also call the studio at 952-212-4456 no sooner than two hours before class begins for a message on class cancellations.

Class Attire
