What a beautiful new Communion Set we have! If you weren't in church on Communion Sunday, I hope you'll be here to see it in February. Here's the very touching story behind it.

I originally designed these trays for my church. Everyone liked them so much that I thought I'd try selling them to others. It turned into our small family business. I did the cutting and gluing. My wife did the staining, and my father helped with packaging and shipping.

Our lives changed dramatically when the war began. We had to leave, and our church community dispersed across different cities and countries. Even so, we still found ways to meet—some in Poland, some in Germany, and some now living in Spain, Norway, Brazil, and so on. Today, our people are spread all over the world.

As for our production, we are still making our trays in Kramatorsk, where we have someone managing everything on the ground and shipping them to different countries. But my wife and I are no longer in Kramatorsk—we had to leave because the city is too close to the front line, about 10 miles away, and it's dangerous to stay there. We now have small children, and we don't want to risk their lives or our own, so we made the difficult decision to relocate. At the moment, we are thinking about the future of our business—whether to move it farther from the front line, as the fighting continues to get closer. Everything is still uncertain, and we are waiting to see what path will be the safest and most viable.
