

### **Bommarito, Alfred**

Alfred Bommarito, 78, of Sebewaing and formerly of Lexington, died Sunday, April 13, 2008 at the Tuscola County Medical Care Facility in Caro following a 2 1/2-year illness.

He was born Dec. 24, 1929 in Detroit, son of the late Frank and Antoinette (Serra) Bommarito.

He was united in marriage to Madeolyn Josephine Tuzzo on Nov. 4, 1950 in Detroit. She preceded him in death on June 26, 1996.
