

He purchased a 21 acre tract of land on the west side of the island from a 41 acre parcel owned by his father. The other half went to his brother, Andrew. 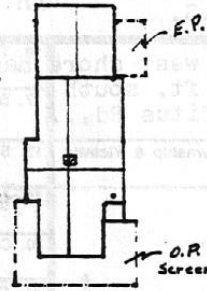

42. (Cont'd) wrap-around front porch, a shed roofed enclosed back porch and a number of replacement windows. A gable-roofed, one-storied frame section in back may also be an addition.

*43. (Cont'd.) a winery on the southern edge of his lot in 1887. Louis Rhein was added as a partner five years later and their business, The Schaedler & Rhein Wine Co. (ERI-1703) became one of the largest wineries on the island.

44. (Cont'd.) Andrew (ERI-1737), is located nearby to the north in an open field. Schaedler also maintained a 28 acre vineyard on his lot which provided one third of the winery's grapes.
