DESCRIPTION: Golden Sovereign's top of the line bow. This is an amazing bow, and helped me win a state championship back in 1967. Beautiful overlays on the back and tips. Brazilian rosewood and black ebonite riser. The limbs have been refinished; the *Lord Mercury* decal is a reproduction. The mercury capsules "giggle" when the bow is shaken, so there may have been some mercury loss over the years. No delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. There may be a couple of professionally filled sight screw holes, but they are very faint and its hard to determine if they are filled holes or just little nicks. . No drilled holes. No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few scratches and scuffs on the limbs. This is a really nice world class recurve in excellent condition for its age.
